NEW COURSE



Adjacent to the Old Course at St Andrews lies the New Course. Don't let the name fool you as this "new" course was built in 1895 by the then "Keeper of the Green" Old Tom Morris. The New Course shares the same plot of land as the Old Course, and the Jubilee, and is a classic test of links golf, especially if the wind is up, with undulating fairways and challenging greens. In fact, many locals prefer the New Course to the Old Course.

RUSACKS HOTEL



4-Star Hotel - St Andrews

Adjacent to the famed 18th on the Old Course sits the iconic Rusacks Hotel. New in 2021, the historic hotel will reopen after a comprehensive and vast renovation, which includes all existing bedrooms, an expansion block adding new bedrooms and addition of a new rooftop restaurant and bar, which will have unparalleled views of the Old Course, Swilcan Bridge and The R&A.

CARNOUSTIE



Ranked 20th in the world and eight-time host of the Open Championship, the Championship course at Carnoustie is regularly regarded as the toughest course in the entire British Isles. Boasting one of the toughest closing stretches in golf (the 15th, 16th and 17th holes) and a plethora of formidable bunkers, golfers will need to be on their game in order to score well. That said, golfers don't have to be named Hogan, Player, Watson or Molinari in order to enjoy themselves on the famed links.

KINGSBARNS



While often considered a modern links course, golf at Kingsbarns dates back to 1793. However, the 27th ranked course in the world only took on its current form in 2000 and is unrecognizable from its previous state to current. What started as a flat field has yielded a links course with mounds, hollows and undulating fairways so natural in look and feel that it's as if they've been there forever.

OLD COURSE



The 6th ranked course is as synonymous with the word "golf" as any other word. The Old Course, or aptly considered "The Home of Golf", has hosted the Open Championship a record 29 times with champions. From the opening tee shot in front of The R&A and the famous double greens to the Road Hole and Swilcan Bridge, every golfer has dreamed of their round on the famed links, where they can walk in the footsteps of legends named Nicklaus, Snead, Jones, Ballesteros, Flado and Woods.

THE MARINE HOTEL



4-Star Hotel - North Berwick

Situated along the coast in North Berwick (overlooking the famed North Berwick West Links no less), lies the 4-star Marine Hotel & Spa. Renowned for its glorious 19th century Victorian architecture, award-winning Craigleith restaurant and full-service spa, the Marine Hotel is not short of anything. With an extensive room renovation scheduled for completion in May 2021, the "new" Marine will undoubtedly be second to none.

GULLANE



Two-time host of the European Tour's Scottish Open and previous host to the Ladies Scottish Open, Gullane is as fascinating as they come. Voted as one of the most picturesque golf spots in the world, the views of the Firth of Forth and across to nearby Muirfield and Luffness New are ones to behold. Stunning views aside, the links on Course No 1 (Gullane is home to 3 courses), is as fine a challenge for any golfer as any course with wonderfully turfed fairways, pot bunkers, true greens and vastly undulating terrain.

NORTH BERWICK



The West Links at North Berwick is ranked 39th in the world and has served as a blueprint for countless courses as they copy numerous holes from the West Links, including the original "Redan" hole. With breathtaking views across the Firth of Forth, deep bunkers, humps, hollows, burns and even a stone wall that you'll have to hit over twice, this is one of the most fun rounds of golf you will ever play.

MUIRFIELD



Muirfield is not only the 3rd ranked course in the world and sixteen-time host to the Open Championship, but is also one of the oldest golf clubs in the world (The Honorable Company of Edinburgh Golfers). The course was originally designed by by Old Tom Morris and later altered by Harry Colt and Tom Simpson. The famed course layout at Muirfield is quite unusual, which consists of two concentric rings of nine holes instead of the simple nine our and nine back layout of most links courses of its time.


Pricing, Terms & Conditions

A current GHIN handicap or similar are required for all guests who are playing golf during this trip and golfers may be asked to present a valid handicap certificate at some courses.



Pricing

Payment Timeline

\$1,500 per person deposit due at the time of registration.

Remaining final balance payment due 90 days prior to departure date.

Cancellation Policy
